[PROPOSED] ORDER

1 WHEREAS, a class action is pending before the Court entitled *Barry v. University of*  
2 *Washington*, Case No. 20-2-13924-6-SEA;

3 WHEREAS, on March 4, 2025, the Court granted preliminary approval of a class action  
4 settlement reached in this case and directed notice to issue to individuals in the Settlement Class  
5 per its Amended Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval;

6 WHEREAS, direct notice issued to some but not all individuals in the Settlement Class and  
7 a modification of the settlement approval schedule is necessary to provide direct notice to 317  
8 individuals in the Settlement Class; and

9 WHEREAS, the parties have filed a Joint Motion to Amend Settlement Approval Schedule  
10 in order for direct notice to issue to 317 individuals in the Settlement Class and to provide them  
11 with an opportunity to opt out of or object to the Settlement Agreement;

12 This matter coming before the Court upon the agreement of the Parties, good cause being  
13 shown, and the Court being fully advised in the premises,

14 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, DECREED, AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

15 1. The Court's Amended Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary  
16 Approval is hereby amended to allow for notice to issue to 317 individuals in the  
17 Settlement Class (the "317 Individuals") pursuant to the terms of that Order and the  
18 Settlement Agreement.

19 2. Pursuant to this Order and the Amended Order Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion  
20 for Preliminary Approval:


21 a. The Notice Plan as applicable to the 317 Individuals shall be completed by July  
22 16, 2025 ("the Supplemental Notice Date") in the manner set forth in Section  
23 4.1 of the Settlement Agreement;

24 b. The 317 Individuals shall have until August 18, 2025 to submit requests to opt  
25 out of the Settlement Agreement, and such opt-out requests shall be submitted  
26 in Accordance with Paragraphs 15, 16, and 17 of the Court's Amended Order  
27 Granting Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary;

- 1 c. The 317 Individuals shall have until August 18, 2025 to submit objections to  
2 the Settlement Agreement, and such objections shall be filed in accordance with  
3 Paragraphs 18, 19, and 20 of the Court's Amended Order Granting Plaintiff's  
4 Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval;
- 5 d. All Settlement Class Members shall have until August 18, 2025 to submit  
6 Election Forms;
- 7 e. Papers in support of final approval of the Settlement Agreement and any  
8 responses to objections (if any) from any Settlement Class  
9 Members/supplementations to the Fee Petition filed on March 16, 2025 shall be  
10 filed with the Court on or before October 3, 2025;
- 11 f. The Final Approval Hearing shall be held before this Court on October 17, 2025  
12 at 10:00 am PT at the Superior Court of the State of Washington in and for King  
13 County, 516 Third Avenue, Courtroom W-817, Seattle, WA, 98104.
